*UN Public Administration Glossary:*

“ ...implies the **involvement of citizens** in a wide range of **policymaking activities**, including the determination of levels of service, budget priorities, and the acceptability of physical construction projects **in order to orient government programs toward community needs, build public support, and encourage a sense of cohesiveness** within neighborhoods.

- ☑ resolved to enhance participation and effective engagement of civil society

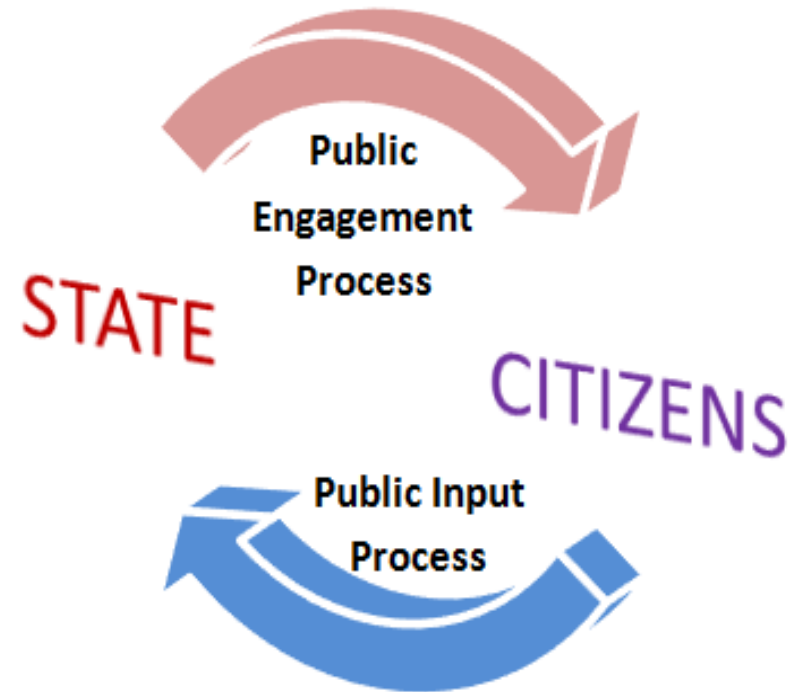


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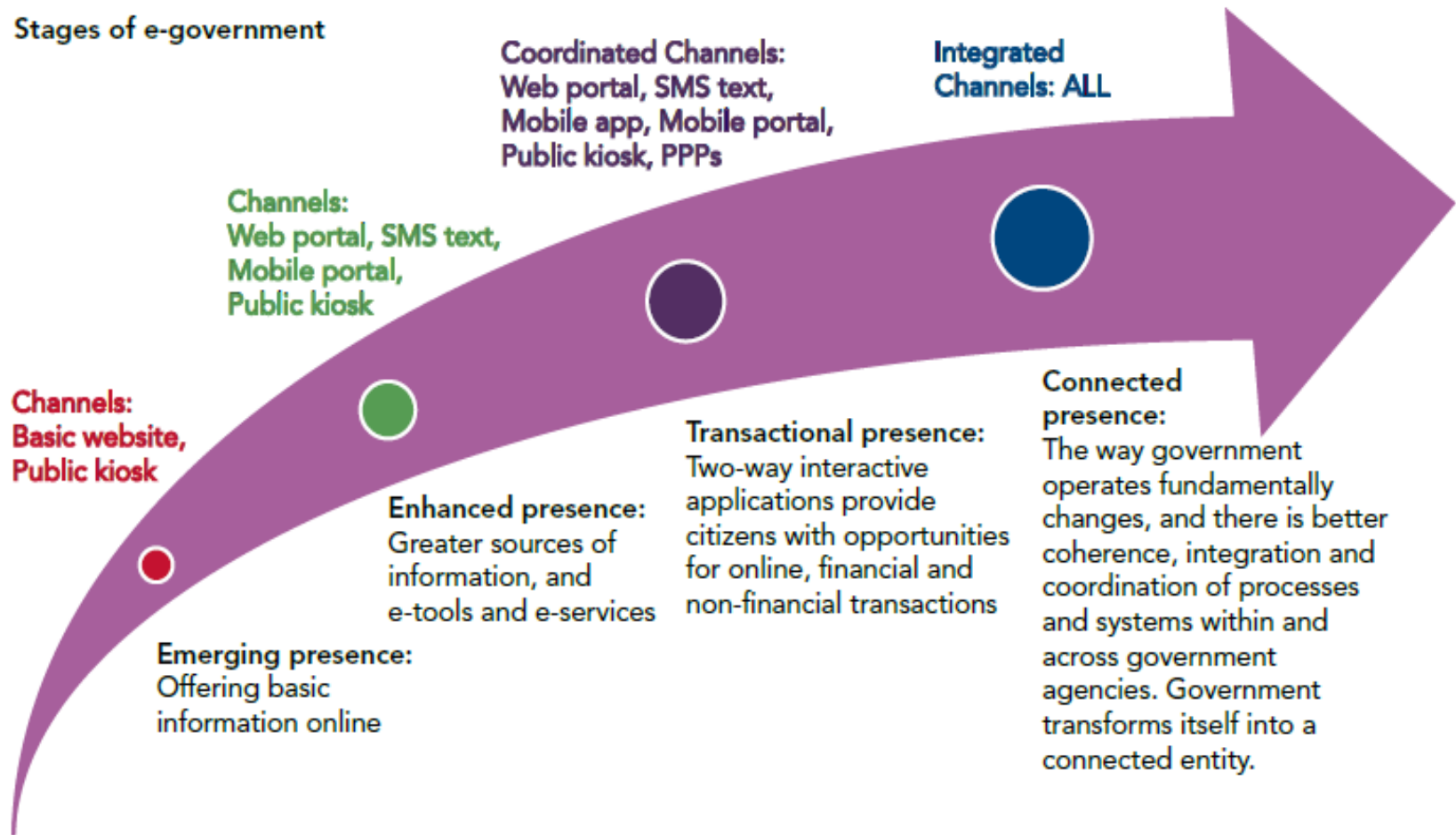
# Participation

# Use ICT for Public Administration

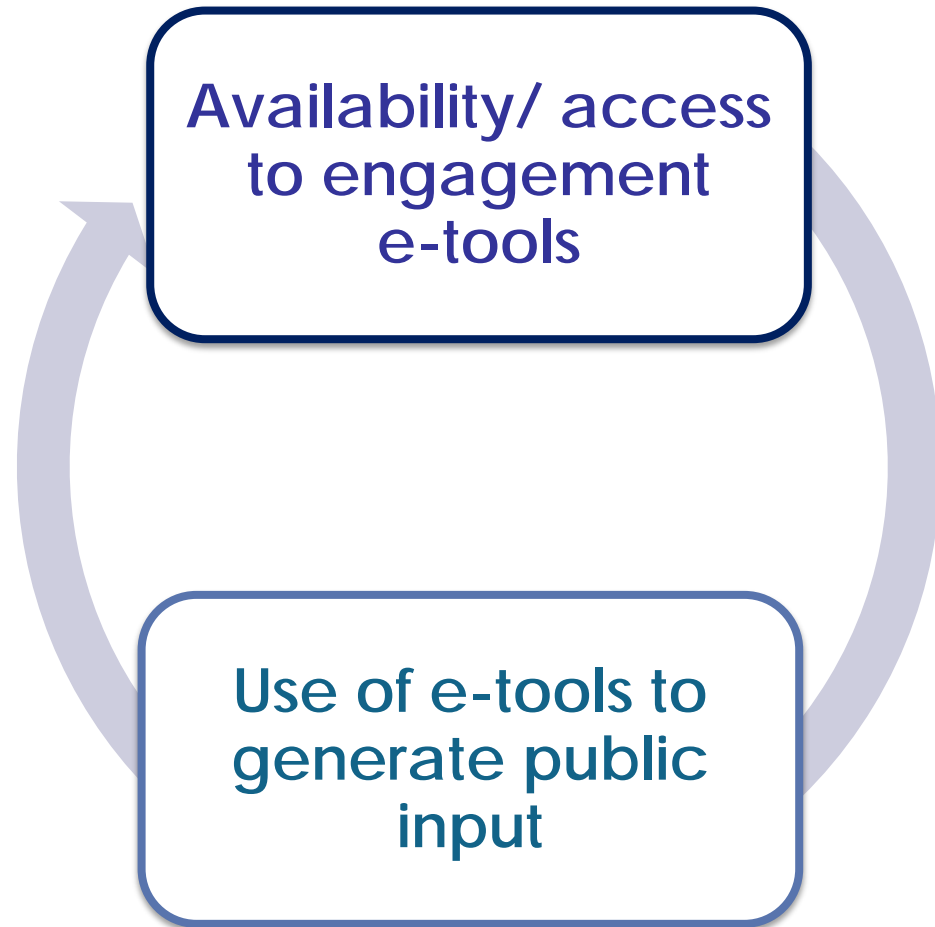
## Stages of e-government

# e-Participation

# e-Participation Maturity Model

Three-stage approach

- **e-Decision-making** – evolving citizens directly in decision processes
- **e-Consultation** – organizing public consultations online
- **e-Information** – provision of information via the Internet

# What is METEP?

METEP is a policy making support & awareness raising tool for measuring & evaluating citizen participation in public affairs via ICT

**METEP** =  
**M**easurement and  
**E**valuation  
**T**ool for  
**E**ngagement and  
**P**articipation





# METEP Project

- Based on UN DESA e-Participation Index
- Project started at 2013 by DPADM
- Discussed at WSIS Forum 2013 in Geneva at the UN DESA Action Lines Facilitators Meeting
- Framework was developed in 2013-2014
- First trials of METEP was in Kazakhstan (October 2014), Azerbaijan (December 2013), Kenya (January 2015) and Iran (March 2015)
- Three initial countries will apply METEP: Kazakhstan Kenya and Indonesia



# METEP Goals

- Help identify and eliminate barriers for participatory development strategies
- Help exploit ICT for effective public engagement tools that are accepted by citizens
- Help develop capacities for evaluating participation progress

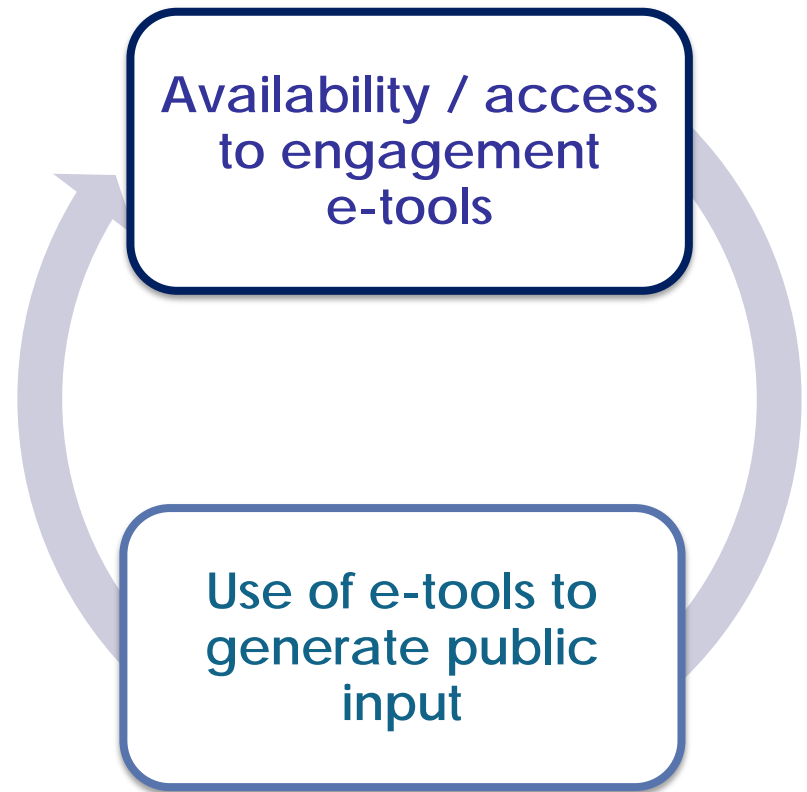
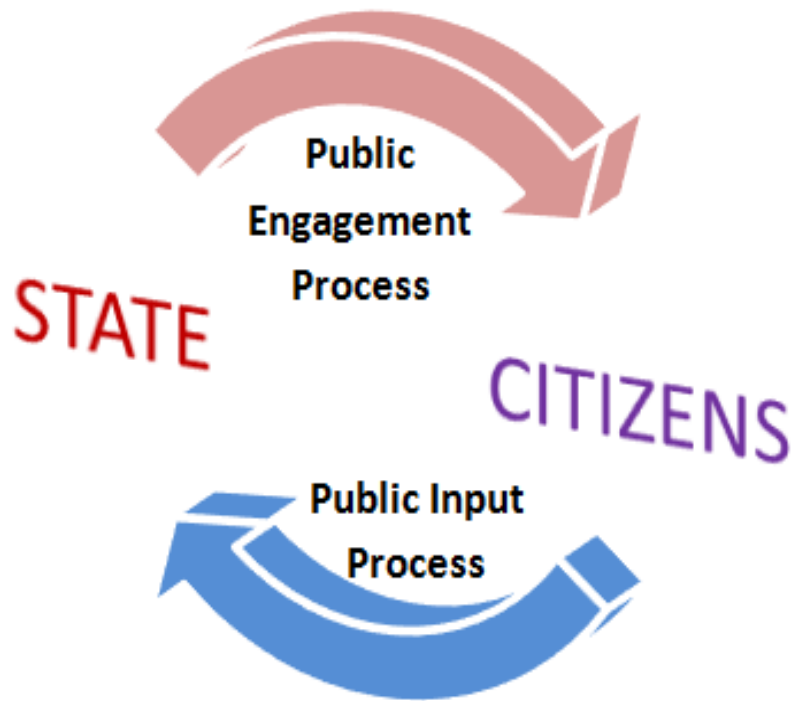

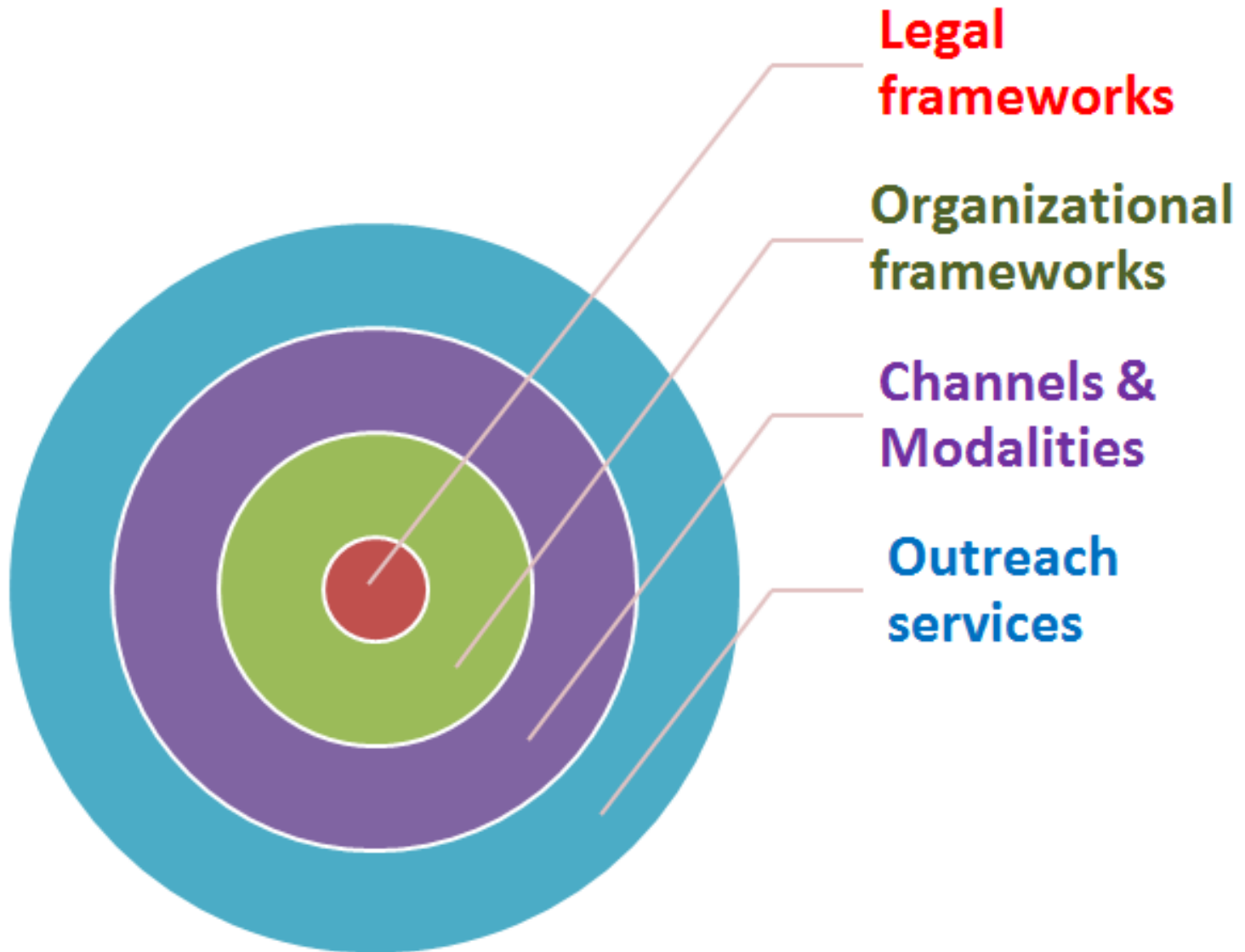

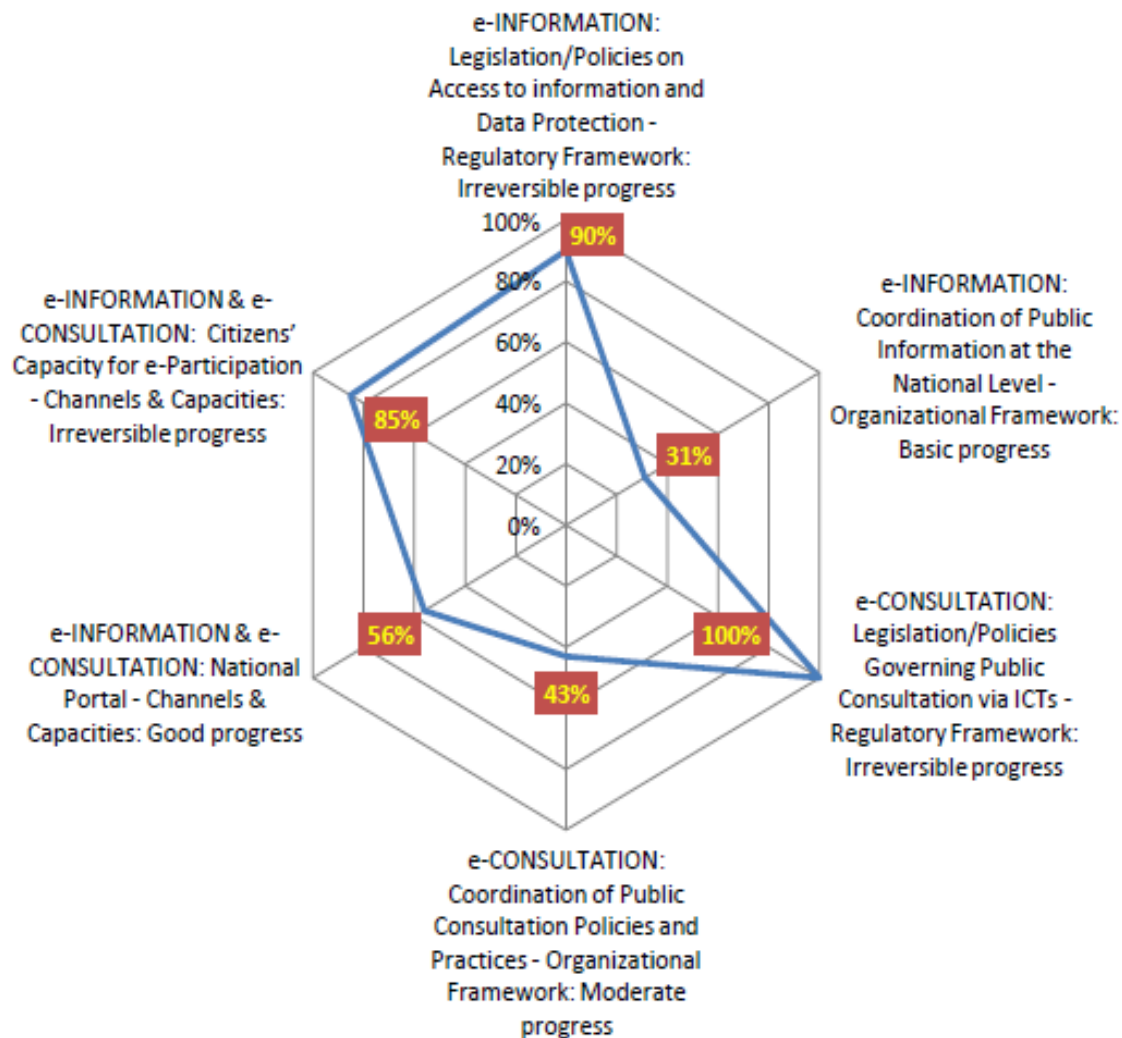

# METEP Data

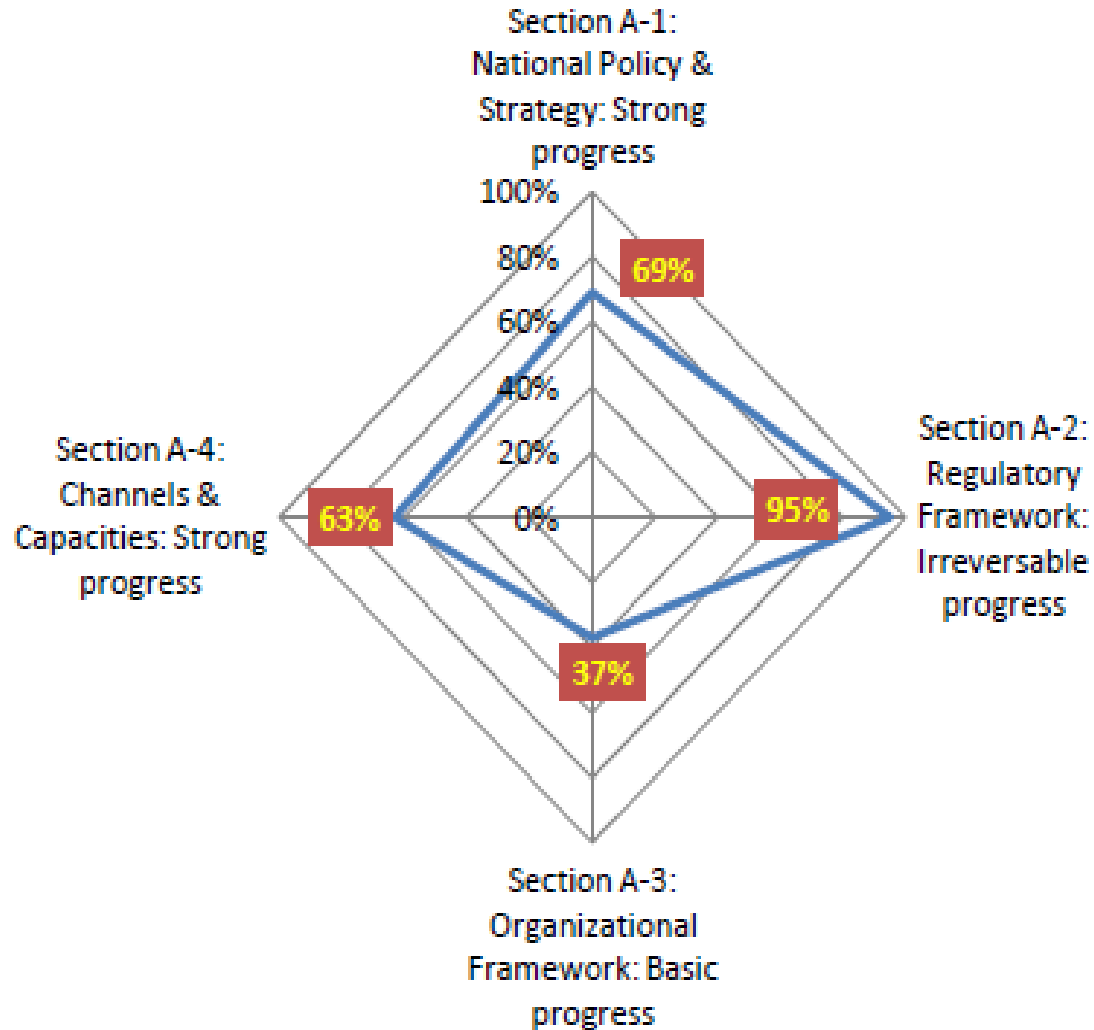
- **Self-assessment questionnaire** for senior/mid level public managers at various government & institutional levels
